Proverbs 29:18 says, “Where there is no vision (mental sight) the people perish...” (KJV) Perish in this verse means to loosen, uncover or dismiss. It makes you confident of success.

God has given me authority, but I must remain humble and gentle because I am under His authority. I love my students. I set a guard over my mouth. I determine to operate in unity with God, patiently bearing with another’s burdens.

I have been given the gift of teaching for the perfecting and edifying of others. I speak the truth in love for the purpose of maturity and intellectual and moral strength. I am being transformed by the renewing of my mind and open myself to your voice to lead me, Lord. I invite You into my day, Holy Spirit, and ask You to fill my classroom with Your presence. I trust in the Lord to keep my students and me safe. We are kept safe by the power of the Lord. The evil one touches us not.
